

#### Get fitted

It's important to get professionally fitted prior to the surgery. We recommend going up a band size to allow for swelling.



### Go wirefree

A wirefree bra will offer greater comfort immediately after surgery, it will also put less pressure on the delicate chest area.



### Choose details for comfort

You should be looking for a secure full coverage shape with a deep centre and underarm edges to avoid irritating the surgery site.

Front-fastening bras will also make putting on or removing your bra much easier.
