- **Comfort first** Choose soft, wire-free bras with front-fastening styles . These are easier to put on and kinder to healing skin.

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AFTER YOUR SURGERY

- **Different options available** Post-surgery bras are designed to suit different types of breast surgery.
- Your first bra should be non-wired, soft, and breathable with a front-fastening design for ease of wear and wide straps for comfort and support.
- Prothesis-friendly styles many bras include discreet pockets for prothesis if required
- **Get refitted** Your body may change after surgery due to swelling. A **professional fitting** ensures your bra supports you gently without pressure or rubbing.

IMMEDIATELY AFTER SURGERY

- Choose front-opening bras for easy dressing.
- Opt for soft, non-wired fabrics to protect sensitive skin.
- If advised by your surgeon , wear a compression style.
- Look for designs with space or discreet pockets for drains.

FINDING THE RIGHT FIT

- Select wide, cushioned straps to ease pressure on the shoulders.
- The band should feel secure but never restrictive.
- Avoid seams that sit directly on scars.
- Visit a specialist bra fitter sizes and fits vary greatly between brands.
